### PREPARE

#### Open your Dacotah Bank Checking Account

- Download our mobile app, and set up your new account.
- Enroll and set up Dacotah Bank Bill Pay.
- Enroll in electronic statements.

#### Organize your Transactions

- Use our Scheduled Debit/Credit Checklist to identify direct deposits, automatic payments and any outstanding checks or payments scheduled in your former checking account.

### MOVE

#### Change your Automatic Payments & Deposits

- Move your Direct Deposits.** Contact your employer's HR department or use the [Direct Deposit Application form](#). If you receive government benefits, be sure to contact the Social Security Administration ( [www.ssa.gov](http://www.ssa.gov) ) or the Veterans Administration (<https://mypay.dfas.mil>) to update your payment account information.
- Set up Automatic Payments & Transfers** Set up to debit your Dacotah Bank checking account using Bill Pay or use the [Automatic Payment Authorization Form](#).

### FINALIZE

#### Track your activity and close your former checking account

- Confirm all direct deposits, as well as automatic payments, have transferred.
- Confirm all outstanding checks and debit card transactions have cleared.
- Contact your former bank to request the account closure or use the [Account Closure Authorization Form](#) and send it to your former financial institution.
- Transfer any remaining balances to your new Dacotah Bank account(s).
- Destroy any unused checks, debit/ATM cards, and deposits slips associated with your former account. Dacotah Bank can also destroy these items for you.
