How to avoid deleting the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie using:




To delete cookies from your system without deleting the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie, click on 'Tools', then on 'Internet Options'.



This will open the following window:


Click 'Delete' to Delete All Cookies

Click 'Settings' to Manually Delete Cookies




If you click on 'Delete' you will see the following window. On this window, if you click on 'Delete Cookies' or 'Delete All' you will delete the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie that has been placed on your system. All other options will not affect the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie that has been placed on your system.

DO NOT CLICK THE COOKIES BOX BELOW




If you want to delete your cookies WITHOUT deleting the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie, you will need to manually delete your cookie. To do this, from the 'Internet Options' screen, click on 'Setting, this will open the following window. From here, you will click on the 'View File' button to display your Temporary Internet Files folder where your cookies are stored.



CLICK VIEW FILES to Manually Delete Cookies


In this folder you can manually delete your cookies. All files that begin with “cookie” are the cookies for the different sites you have visited. The Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie will look similar to the following image except will have your banks name in place of ‘ohnward.sharepoint’ and your user ID in place of ‘hperrone.’ There may be more than one cookie that looks similar to this one, please leave all of these cookies.




Firefox

Firefox can be set to automatically delete all cookies every time it closes. If this is the case then your Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie will be deleted. To check your setup, follow the steps below.


You will need to open the Firefox options screen by clicking on ‘Tools’ and then on ‘Internet Options’. See the following screen shot for reference.



On the options window that opens, click on the Privacy Icon at the top to get to the section we need to make sure we are not deleting the Authentication Cookie. From here, you will click on the 'Settings' button in the Private Data Section.




On the Clear Private Data section, we want to make sure that the drop down next to 'Accept third-party cookies and site data' is set to 'Always.' We also want to make sure that the 'Keep until' drop down is set to 'They expire'.



This should prevent Firefox from deleting the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie.

Google Chrome

To delete cookies from your system without deleting the Ohnward Bancshares Authentication Cookie, click on 'More Tools', then on 'Clear browsing data...'



Make sure the Cookies and other site data box is UNCHECKED on both the Basic Tab and Advanced Tab.
